

Your HSA and Prescription Drugs

If you take an ongoing medication or even need an occasional prescription drug, you may be wondering how prescription drugs are handled under an HSA compatible medical plan.

How are prescription drugs covered?	Under a high deductible plan, prescription drugs are covered the same as any other medical care such as a doctors' office visit or lab test. This means until you meet your deductible, you pay the full cost of the prescription drug at the pharmacy.
How can I reduce my prescription costs?	Because you are spending money from your own pocket or from your HSA to pay for prescriptions, it is to your advantage to use network pharmacies, request generic drugs, and order maintenance medications through mail order.
Can I use my HSA to pay for OTC medicines?	Reimbursement for some over-the-counter (OTC) medicines or drugs will be allowed only with a doctor's prescription. See the lists below for examples. For a complete list of qualified medical care expenses, refer to IRS Publication 502 .
